

South Aero Inc.

South Aero began operations in November, 1982 and is based in Albuquerque. The carrier offers charter and freighter services with a fleet primarily consisting of Cessna 208B Grand Caravan and Cessna 404 Titan aircraft. The carrier also owns a single Cessna 402 and a single Cessna 414 and has retired a fleet of Cessna T210M Turbo Centurion's. South Aero provides feeder service for UPS aircraft at Albuquerque and flights are operated from Albuquerque to Alamogordo, Gallup, Farmington, Las Vegas, Tucumcari, Clovis, Roswell, Carlsbad, Hobbs, Las Cruces, and Silver City, New Mexico. Service to Deming, New Mexico is also provided from mid-November through December each year. Flag stops are sometimes made at Grants and Socorro, New Mexico. Ameriflight provided the feeder service for UPS throughout New Mexico between September 2014 and March, 2019 then South Aero returned to all cities. South Aero also operates from Phoenix to Flagstaff and Safford, Arizona.
