iAero Airways

Swift Air is a charter airline founded in 1997 and based in Phoenix, Arizona. The carrier first began operating with Embraer 135 regional jets and has since escalated to Boeing 737-300's, -400's, and -800's. Swift Air operated casino charter flights from Albuquerque to Wendover, Nevada and also performed flights from Albuquerque to Guatemala City, Guatemala and San Pedro Sula, Honduras to return illegal immigrants to Mexico during 2017. In mid-2017, Swift Air acquired the new Eastern Airlines. The new Eastern was founded in 2010 as Dynamic Airways, and is now based in Miami, Florida. The carrier formerly flew Boeing 737-700 and 737-800 aircraft and operated presidential campaign charters through Albuquerque and Las Cruces in 2016. Eastern now flies an all wide-body fleet of Boeing 767 and 777 aircraft.

In 2019 Swift Air became a subsidiary of iAero Group and began rebranding itself as iAero Airways. The carrier operates charters from Albuquerque to Laughlin and Reno, Nevada on behalf of Caesar's Entertainment. Charters for sports teams and other entities are also flown through Albuquerque.
