

AirTransit

AirTransit was a commuter airline that operated from 1963 through 1967 and based in Show Low, Arizona. The carrier flew routes from Phoenix to several small communities in the White Mountains of east central Arizona using DeHavilland Dove and other types of small prop aircraft. By early 1966, AirTransit expanded to Albuquerque operating four flights per day to Phoenix, two were nonstop and two made stops in Window Rock, Holbrook, and Show Low, Arizona.
