



## JetAire

JetAire was established in 1984 and based in Albuquerque operating a pair of Handley-Page Jetstream aircraft. The initial schedule began on January 16, 1985 with four daily roundtrip flights between Albuquerque and Las Cruces, New Mexico. Only one of the two aircraft was operated while the other was used only for spare parts. On April 1, 1985 the carrier dropped one Las Cruces roundtrip and added an Albuquerque-Lubbock-Clovis-Albuquerque trip. This flight lasted for only 16 days before being discontinued and the fourth Las Cruces roundtrip was reinstated. On June 3, 1985 a roundtrip flight between Albuquerque and Alamogordo was started in an effort to gain the Essential Air Service (EAS) subsidy for service to Alamogordo after Airways of New Mexico had ceased operating on the route. The EAS was awarded to Mesa Airlines however and JetAire discontinued their Alamogordo flight within a couple months. Service to Santa Fe later began and new service to Taos was planned for the upcoming ski season however JetAire ceased operating on January 14, 1986.
