

Truth or Consequences Municipal Airport

The Truth or Consequences Municipal Airport is a general aviation airfield serving Truth or Consequences, Elephant Butte, and Sierra County, New Mexico. It is located seven miles north of the city of Truth or Consequences, formerly known as Hot Springs, New Mexico until 1950. The airport has five runways however only one is paved and the other four are seldom used.

The airport was first constructed in the 1930's as an emergency landing site along an airway between Albuquerque and El Paso. Many of the original structures, equipment, and markers are still present on the airfield today. **Continental Airlines** briefly served the airport with Douglas DC-3's in the early 1950's as one of several stops on a route between Denver and El Paso.
